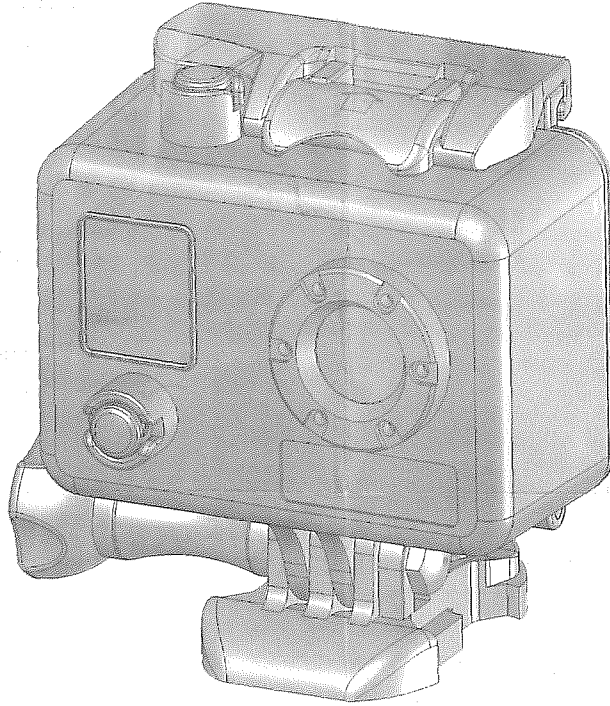


Tips for using your Motorsports HERO.



READ THE INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR CAMERA.

Your camera has many unique settings for motorsports. It is not recommended to learn by trial and error.

NiMH rechargeable or Lithium batteries are highly recommended.

Alkaline batteries are provided for convenience but are not recommended for ongoing use.

Alkaline batteries quickly fail in cold temperatures and during high vibration situations. NiMH and Lithium batteries perform very well in motorsports applications. After much testing, GoPro Factory Racing recommends Energizer and Duracell NiMH rechargeable batteries above all else.

The Motorsports HERO camera housing is made of strong polycarbonate and is waterproof to 100'.

IMPORTANT! You must keep the rubber seal of the camera housing clean. A single hair or grain of sand can cause a leak. To clean the seal, simply remove it from the camera housing and rinse it in fresh water. Shake it dry to avoid lint and re-install it into the back door of the housing. This will maintain the waterproof performance of your Motorsports HERO housing.

IMPORTANT! Your camera has a HI/LO selectable sound setting in the SET menu of options. Choose LO anytime your camera is mounted on a vibrating surface like a car or motorcycle, etc. This will result in excellent sound that is not overloaded by the low frequencies created by vibration. You can use the HI setting when mounted on helmets or other non vibrating equipment, but if wind noise is too loud continue to use the LO sound setting. The HI sound setting is typically best for non-motorsports activities.

Use RAIN-X or a similar anti-beading solution to avoid waterspots on the lens when using in rain or water.
